UCC Statement of Faith (In Dialogue)

Pastor: You say you believe in God? What kind of God?

All: We believe in God, the Eternal Spirit, God of our Lord Jesus Christ and our God, to God's deeds we testify: God calls the worlds into being, creates persons in God's

own image, and sets before each one the ways of life and death.

Pastor: But does God really care about people?

All: God seeks in holy love to save all people from aimlessness and sin. God judges

people and nations by God's righteous will, declared through prophets and

apostles.

Pastor: You speak of God's will "declared through prophets and apostles". But how do you know what your God is really like?

All: In Jesus Christ, the man of Nazareth, our crucified and risen Lord, God has come to us and shared our common lot, conquering sin and death, and reconciling the world to himself.

Pastor: So you believe in a God who creates the world and was in this man Jesus Christ. Does God have any direct connection with people...with you and me?

All: God bestows on us the Holy Spirit, creating and renewing the church of Jesus Christ, binding in covenant faithful people of all ages, tongues, and races.

Pastor: How does God expect this "binding together" to come about?

All: God calls us into the church to accept the cost and joy of discipleship, to be God's servants in the service of others, to proclaim the gospel to all the world and resist the powers of evil, to share in Christ's baptism and eat at his table, to join him in his passion and victory.

Pastor: We live in troubled times. How can we do all those things and make a difference?

All: God promises to all who trust in God forgiveness of sins and fullness of grace, courage in the struggle for justice and peace, God's presence in trial and rejoicing, and eternal life in God's Kingdom which has no end.

Pastor: Forgiveness—courage—God's presence—eternal life! This a God I can trust and serve. Let us join together in praising Him.

All: Blessing and honor, glory and power be unto God. Amen.


